Dear Parents

As you know each year St Joseph's, along with every other Catholic School in the Diocese of Salford, receives an invoice from the Diocese for the Building Fund. This is to enable our Catholic schools to make improvements to their buildings and facilities. We have received our demand from the Diocese for the Building Fund for 2017/2018 and are asking all our parents to make a contribution of **£16** per child towards this fund.

Pupils regularly identify school buildings and facilities as one of their main priorities for improvement, we will not be able to achieve these improvements without your support of the Building Fund. This year we have refurbished the boys and girls toilets with support from this funding.

Funding from previous years has enabled us to totally refurbish the school chapel, relocate one and refurbish an I.T. rooms, refurbish the Library, upgrade ICT facilities, , provide new carpets, tables and chairs in classrooms and improve site security. All pupils benefit from these improvements.

If you are a taxpayer and have not already completed a Gift Aid Declaration Form, please ask for a form to be returned when you send in your payment. Gift Aid means that we can claim 20 pence for each £1.00 that is sent into school for the School Building Fund.

I am appealing once again, to your generosity in making this voluntary contribution.
