Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to confirm the final arrangements for the reward trip which is scheduled for this Friday, 20th October.

All pupils going to Blackpool are invited to attend in non-uniform.

All pupils that were invited to Blackpool but are staying in school may also attend in non-uniform.

All pupils who were not invited onto the trip should attend school in normal uniform.

Detailed below are the guidelines which we employ whenever the school has a non-uniform day, we would ask that you help us to ensure that these are followed. Given the time of year we would also ask that the dress chosen for those visiting Blackpool is suitable for the expected weather.

Non-Uniform Day Regulations

1. As always, no make-up, false tan, earrings, piercings or jewellery to be worn.
2. No leggings or skinny jeans UNLESS a long shirt, cardigan or jumper is mid-thigh length.
3. No strappy vests, low tops, backless or 'cut out' T-shirts to be worn.
4. No 'midriffs' showing.
5. No shorts of any sort.
6. No hats to be worn in school. If worn on the yard or at Blackpool – the face must be clearly visible.
7. No hair colourings, extreme hairstyles or hair gel to be worn.
8. No Onesies.
9. BOYS – No low slung trousers

There will be a range of activities taking place during the day for those pupils who were invited, but are not going on the trip. One of these is the opportunity to select from a range of films and during this time Miss Rushton will be running a small tuck shop from which the pupils can purchase some treats should they wish to do so.

We are hoping to leave school as soon as possible after the normal start to the school day so please ensure that you child is prompt to school. We are due to return to school around 3.15pm to ensure that pupils who need to catch a bus home at 3.30pm will be able to do so.





As soon as we arrive back to school we intend to allow those pupils who walk home, are picked up, or catch service buses to leave. We will as usual supervise pupils who are waiting for school buses on the school site.

There are 35 staff accompanying the trip who will be circulating around the Pleasure Beach throughout the day. In addition to this Mr Singleton will have the school mobile with him should the pupils need to contact a member of staff urgently. It would be of assistance to us if you could ensure that the number for the school mobile – 07906 407386, is entered into your child's phone in advance.

Please remind your child that they are representing our school and that exemplary behaviour is expected throughout the day. This includes being at the meeting point by the main entrance gates at 2pm so that students can be registered safely before boarding the bus home without delay.

We have chosen Blackpool Pleasure Beach as it ideal for school groups as the site is enclosed and the pupils cannot leave the site once they have entered. The pupils will be escorted from the buses, directly into the Pleasure Beach when we arrive, and back to the buses when we are leaving.
